**Topic: Survivors**



**Choice of tasks for Home Learning**

Your Home Learning task should reflect the time that you have been given to complete it. Please show us your best efforts. We would love to share these projects in class and on our Home Learning display.

These are only suggested home learning tasks, please feel free to speak to your class teacher about any other ideas that you may have.

<b>I enjoy reading, writing and speaking</b>	<p>Write a script for an interview with a character from one of the books we are recommending you read, linked to our topic (Kenzuki's Kingdom, Anne Frank and Goldfish Boy, Sands of the Scorpion, The Explorer)</p> <p>Write a narrative where the main character encounters a situation in which they will need to use specific survival skills.</p>
<b>I enjoy working with numbers and being scientific</b>	<p>Select an environment (desert, rainforest, etc.) and create your own animal that is adapted to survive in it. For example, it could have six legs to help it climb in a rainforest.</p> <p>Create a chart to show the climate in different biomes. (You may wish to include rainfall or temperatures).</p>
<b>I enjoy painting and drawing</b>	<p>Use a variety of recycled materials to create something that will help you survive on a desert island.</p> <p>Create a landscape piece of art, which depicts one of the environments that we have been learning about – e.g. Deserts or Jungles.</p>
<b>I enjoy being active and doing hands-on activities</b>	<p>Design and build a model treehouse or tepee.</p> <p>Do something muddy and evidence it in some way!</p>
<b>I enjoy working by myself</b>	<p>Research a famous survivor (Bear Grylls, Anne Frank, Captain Scott, etc.) and create a biography/fact file for them.</p>
<b>I enjoy learning about the world around me</b>	<p>Create your own outdoor bush trial using only natural resources.</p> <p>Research an animal native to the UK (hedgehog, badger, woodpecker, etc.) and create a presentation for it. For example, for a hedgehog, you could create a hide for it and leave food out in the garden – you would need to make sure you research what would be appropriate for them first!</p>

**Or:** come up with your own Survivors project – whatever you choose, make sure it is something you will enjoy learning more about!
