



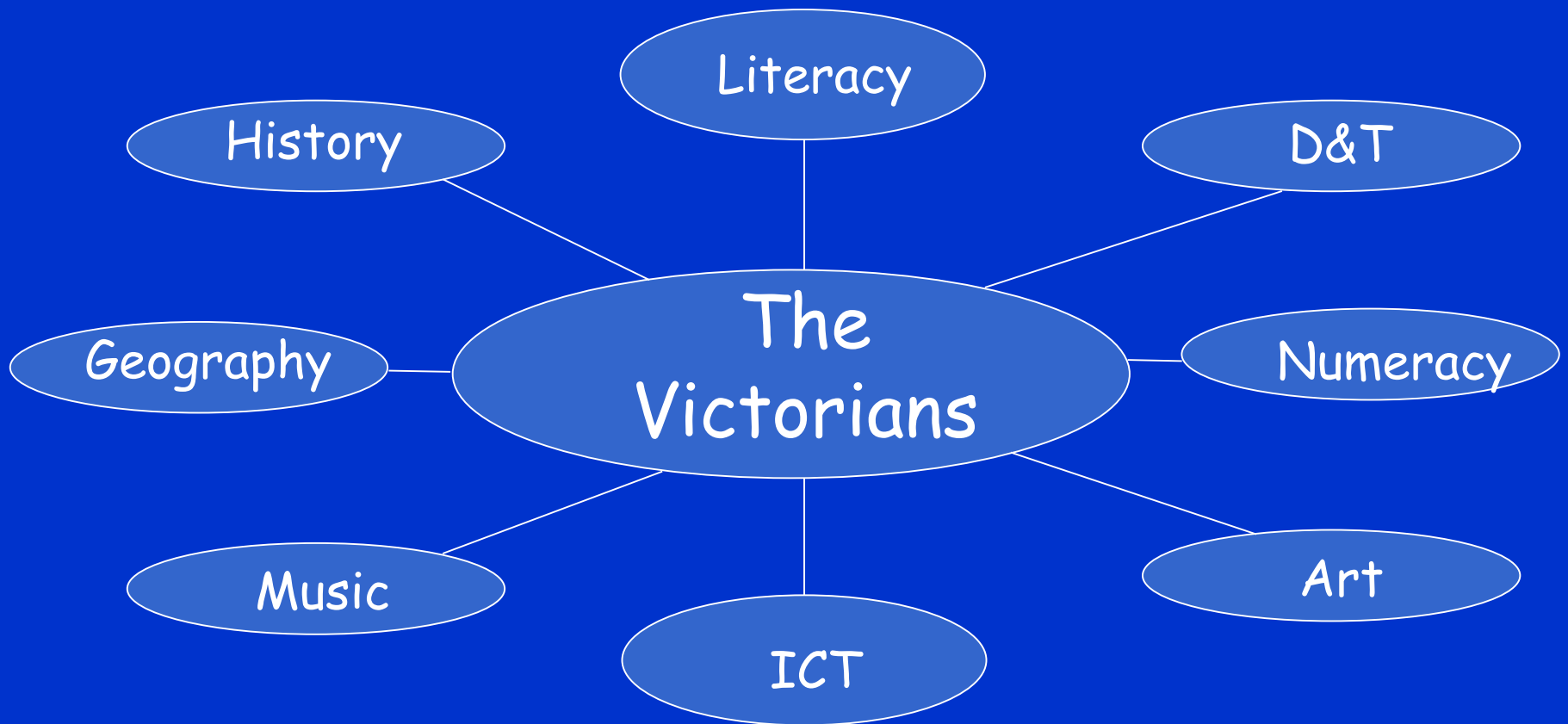

Skills based Curriculum

- Topic based learning:



Reading

- Please sign reading records every weekend and every time your child has read (daily).
- Every day we will check reading records for reading and parent/guardian signatures and stamp them ourselves.
- Please ensure that your child reads every night (20 minutes).
- Learning key words and asking questions about the books that they are reading.

Literacy

Areas of learning this term:

- Spellings - Spellings are set weekly on Spelling Shed and will be tested termly.
- Big Writing - Setting description, Mystery Narrative, Day in the Life.
- Writing for a purpose - making links.
- Expectations of presentation.

Numeracy

Areas of learning this term - Place Value & Number Operations

- Daily Arithmetic Work.
- Real life problem solving.
- Written and mental strategies.
- To know and apply knowledge of all the times tables up to x12 by the end of year 4 (daily practice).
- Presentation of learning.
