I enjoy reading, writing and speaking.	Find a poem or short story about trees or the woods and practice reading it aloud at home. Can you perform it to the class? Or Find out some facts about a woodland animal and create a poster.
I enjoy working with numbers and being scientific.	Go for a walk in the woods. How many different living things can you find? You could take photographs of what you find. Or Find some leaves and measure them. What is the biggest/smallest leaf you can find?
I enjoy painting and drawing.	Go for a walk in the woods. Collect items along the way and create a collage. Or Draw/paint a tree. You could then label all of the key parts.
I enjoy being active and doing hands-on activities.	Create an object which could have belonged to one of the characters in the tale of Little Red Riding Hood Or Create a model of a woodland animal.
I enjoy working by myself.	What is camouflage? Find one example of an animal that lives in the woods that uses camouflage. You could present what you discover in a poster. Or Make a list/draw 3 things from the woods that are:- .1) Alive 2) Have once lived 3) Have never lived
