

# Year 5 Home Learning

## Choice of tasks for Home Learning

Your Home Learning task should reflect the time that you have been given to complete it. Please show us your best efforts, we will be showing these in class and displaying them in our school. These are only suggested home learning tasks, please feel free to speak to your class teacher about any other ideas that you may have!

Please keep the size of the projects to A3 size or smaller as we have limited space to display these in school and we would like to ensure all projects can be celebrated throughout the term on our home learning display.

<b>I enjoy reading, writing and speaking</b>	You have discovered a brand new, never seen before creature in uncharted land. Create a non-chronological report or poster to introduce the world to your amazing discovery. Create a script for a new documentary series about a country of your choice. Can you comment on the climate, land use and wild-life?
<b>I enjoy working with numbers and being scientific</b>	Research a famous explorer and create a timeline to showcase their lifetime. Research the life cycle of creature of your choice. Can you compare this to another animal—what is the same or different?
<b>I enjoy using creativity and art materials</b>	Create a miniature model of a homemade shelter using things from nature. This could be a tent, wigwam lean-to etc. Create a playlist of 'survival music', commenting on the dynamics, tempo, pitch, beat etc of each song.
<b>I enjoy being active and doing hands-on activities</b>	Go on a walk with your family, take pictures of your adventure and describe them or make a video diary of your time outside (Attenborough style!) Can you create your own Bear Grylls challenges for your family to experience? Document their successes and challenges in a way of your choice.
<b>I enjoy working by myself</b>	Can you create a detailed drawing of an animal which has adapted for survival? Watch a wildlife documentary (or similar) and create a carefully presented mind map of what you find out to share with the class.
<b>I enjoy learning about the world around me</b>	Create an 'essential survival kit' with all of the things you might need if stranded in a deserted landscape. Explore an aspect of life from different countries around the world—e.g how and why is the climate different in different countries? Or what is transport like around the world? What styles of clothing are chosen in different countries and why?

## Resilience project:

Create a survival guide for next year's year 5s to help them settle in. Think about what has been important to you this year and the routines which we have in year 5. Which tips would you have found helpful when joining year 5? How could you help someone who might be nervous about moving up ?
