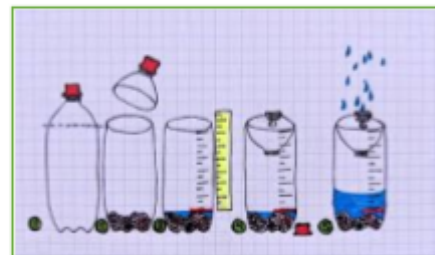
Join Maddie Do You Know as she visits the beach. She will teach you why we have waves in the sea.
