I enjoy reading, writing and speaking.	<p>Research some famous mysterious occurrences in history. Create a fact-file about your favourite mystery.</p> <p>Or</p> <p>Present a news report of a famous unexplained mystery. This could be presented as a video or a newspaper report.</p>
I enjoy working with numbers and being scientific.	<p>Can you create a potato battery? Can you find out how it works?</p> <p>Or</p> <p>Aliens may exist - we just haven't found them yet! Can you research different stars or galaxies and calculate how long it would take for aliens from these places to travel to Earth.</p>
I enjoy painting and drawing.	<p>Find out about surrealist artists such as Salvador Dali. Create your own surrealist piece of art.</p> <p>Or</p> <p>Create your own optical illusion. You could use the artwork of MC Escher to inspire you.</p>
I enjoy being active and doing hands-on activities.	<p>Make a model of the Mary Celeste in any way you choose.</p> <p>Or</p> <p>Learn a magic trick or tricks. Be prepared to show what you have learnt to your class!</p>
I enjoy working by myself.	<p>Choose an unexplained phenomenon such as: crop circles, UFOs or The Bermuda Triangle. Research your phenomena and then try to either prove or disprove their existence/causes.</p> <p>Or</p> <p>Use an online music app such as Chrome Music Lab to create a strange, peculiar or spooky piece of music.</p>
