We would like children to bring in a **donation** for the cause.

The phase leaders will lead assemblies with their year groups during the week leading up to the Friday 1<sup>st</sup> April to ensure the input is age appropriate. We will also be taking donations to give to Big Jig's in Folkestone which are supporting the cause. If you have any of the following and are able to donate it, we would be very grateful.

## **Items for donation**

- baby formula (especially hypoallergenic one - huge shortage)
- baby feeding bottles, sterilising equipment (nothing electric - different sockets)
- baby food and nappies - any sizes
- painkiller medication, especially children's
- charging banks for mobile phones
- warm socks/gloves/warm hats
- camping mats and sleeping bags
- protein/energy bars
- anti-flu medication (Lemsips etc)
- wound dressings
- first aid kits
- warm blankets and thermal/base layers
- hot water bottles
- insulated flasks
- female sanitary products
- any clean soft toys/teddy bears
- a letter/ card of hope and support from children and families.
