Dear Parents/Guardians of the children in Year 4,

We are excited to announce the return of the Year 4 camping trip!

We are looking forward to returning to Kearsney Campsite in Dover. This will be a two-night residential adventure, leaving on Wednesday, 8th June and returning on Friday 10th June.

During the excursion, as well as lots of camp-site fun such as wide games and rounders plus the excitement of sleeping in the great outdoors, we also have an exciting agenda planned. We will be venturing off to Dover beach and the Water Sports Centre for a day of fun-filled sailing, rafting and power boating. We will be visiting Dover Castle where the children can immerse themselves in the history of the castle and spending the afternoon investigating the local area Kearsney gardens and woodland, using their map-making and compass skills in a practical setting. We will also be spending a whole day at Betteshanger Park where we will be accessing adventure games, having campfires and a go at some orienteering.

The payment for the three-day trip is **estimated at £145.00**. The price includes the hire of camping equipment, coach travel, food, entry to attractions and refreshments. We are sure you'll agree this excursion is good value for money. Given that costs have risen extensively over the last few years, we have worked hard to keep the costs equal to those of previous years. If you anticipate having any difficulty with these payments, please contact the school office who will be happy to discuss alternative payment plans with you.
