- **Explore** it Students will have the opportunity to explore the area and learn about the different types of trees and animals that live in this environment.
- Conserve it First and foremost, the aim of the area is to create an amazing habitat area for mini beasts. This is located behind the pond and the groups will learn about the different types of mini beasts that live there, whilst creating fantastic habitats for them to live in.
- Share it All of the student's families will be invited to come and see what has been achieved date to be confirmed.
