Dear Parents and Carers,

After-school clubs will commence week beginning **Monday 6th November** (second week of term).

These are run by staff on a voluntary basis and whilst they clearly give the children great learning opportunities, they do add to staff workload. For this reason, and for the development of skills each week, I must insist that if your child is given a space in a club, they attend every session. If your child is absent from school due to illness their absence from the club is to be expected, other than this we ask children and parents to commit to each session.

We will continue to offer paid for clubs run completely by external providers. Page 2 of this letter details all clubs on offer this term, the day of the club and finish times. More information including links to pay will follow separately. Any communication with these club leaders should be direct to the contact details they provide. Please bear in mind these clubs must meet a minimum number to enable them to be run

If you would like to apply for a club space for your child: **Staff run clubs go live on Arbor at 7pm on Monday 16th October** and will close at 7pm on Friday 27th October. The only way to allocate fairly will be on a first come first served basis. We also ask that you **do not book multiple clubs on the same day** and limit one booking per child per day, for each offered club.

For staff led clubs; if you receive an Arbor message stating you have registered for the club this means you have successfully gained a place and this will show on your child's Arbor account under clubs. If the club is full it will not let you book a membership period and will not take you to the next screen. For external clubs, the club lead will be in touch directly to confirm whether your child has gained a space.
