Your child should now be aware of their role for the Nativity. Please could you provide a costume for your child following the description below. If you are unable to provide a costume or are unsure about the description, please do not hesitate to come and talk to us.

Narrators – Dressed in Christmas style clothes - Christmas jumpers, bright colours, sparkles!

Fir Trees – Tree outfits would be great but alternatively, black or brown trousers with a green top.

Woodcutter – A lumberjack style shirt with jeans.

Woodland animals - We need squirrels, owls, foxes and rabbits. Animal costumes of these would be great but alternatively, brown trousers and a top with some homemade ears will be fine.

Children - Pyjamas or leggings/trousers and a t-shirt.

Nurses - A doctor or nurse style costume or alternatively a white dress/top and leggings.

Wise Men – Brightly coloured kings' outfits; gold, frankincense and myrrh props.



Mary & Joseph – Traditional Nativity costumes would be great. Alternatively, tunic style outfits with a headdress.



Angels - Angel outfit.



Shepherds – Shepherd Nativity costume with a large stick/staff.



Sheep – Sheep costumes or black leggings and cotton wool stuck to a white T-Shirt.

Your child will be required to wear their costume on the following dates:

Monday 5th December – dress rehearsal to the school

Tuesday 6th December - afternoon performance to parents at 2pm.

Wednesday 7th December - performance to parents at 5pm.

Please can you send your child's costume into school in a named carrier bag by Thursday 1st December.
