Wow! The rain has been coming down hard and fast! We're not sure where it has all suddenly come from. Our first experience of the wet weather with Opal has definitely been a steep learning curve.



WE THANK YOU FOR YOUR PATIENCE WHILST WE ESTABLISH OUR OPAL WINTER RULES AND ROUTINES WHILST THIS IS ALL SO NEW TO US.

As you know, we are passionate about ensuring that our children can play outside, explore nature and take part in active playtimes to encourage fitness, health benefits and improved concentration. We believe that every child should have access to amazing, high quality play opportunities during every playtime, every day — with no exceptions.

We have recently had to make some changes to our play offer but we are not allowing this to stop us from offering amazing playtimes for all children. The changes include:

- Whilst the field is so wet and slippery, it will be out of bounds to our children. We are working on ways to build pathways to various areas of the field (e.g. the mud kitchen and the outdoor classroom) and if anyone is able to offer help with this, it would be greatly appreciated. Please do let us know if you are able to offer any help with digging these pathways in the next week or so.
- Our children will still need to wear their outdoor shoes outside for playtimes—we recommend wellies whilst the weather is so wet. We are awaiting an order for more welly racks (like the ones outside Year 1). In the meantime, we will be storing more of the children's shoes on make-shift racks inside our classrooms to keep them dry.
- We are looking to buy some coat rails to hang wet coats on in classrooms—if you are able to provide coat hangers, please do send these in.
- ♦ We will be looking to offer many new and exciting play opportunities on the playgrounds and in the courtyards over the winter months—watch this space!
