<b>Year 1</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ In term 2, we will not be completing outdoor learning every week like we did in term 1. Therefore, your child will no longer need to wear their outdoor learning clothes every Friday. If we do any outdoor learning sessions next term we will let you know prior if your child will need outdoor clothes. <p><b>Year 4</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Year 4 swimming will commence week beginning 31<sup>st</sup> October. This will be every Tuesday morning and will run through term 2</li> <li>❖ Reminders: Our PE days will be on Tuesdays (Swimming) and Wednesdays. When swimming, as in Year 3, children should come to school in their PE kit with their swimming clothes on underneath. This makes for a quick entrance into the pool and easier changing afterwards.
