#### **Important Tapestry update!**

We have some exciting Tapestry updates for you all.

We are very happy to say that we have now set up parental permissions for Tapestry for all year groups within the school for all families who have consented to having an account.

Over the next few days you will receive an email from Tapestry with your account activation details. If you do not receive this email by **Tuesday 16**<sup>th</sup> **January 3pm,** please contact Jackie Chambers (hos@reptonmanor.kent.sch.uk).

We are sure that you will enjoy seeing your child's learning on Tapestry and we are delighted that we can share this with you. There are just a few important details that we need to share with you about the use of Tapestry in our school before we can get started:

- Tapestry is used in our school as an online learning journal it is essentially an online exercise book.
- Our teachers will post some of your child's learning on Tapestry and some of their learning will continue to be recorded in their exercise books.
- Practical learning is more likely to be posted on Tapestry.
- Teachers in EYFS, Key Stage One and Key Stage Two use Tapestry very differently. EYFS and Key Stage One children are likely to have more posts each week than Key Stage Two children. Key Stage Two teachers will not monitor Tapestry as closely as EYFS or Key Stage One Teachers.
- Some children will have more learning posted on Tapestry than others. This may be because their learning is of a more practical nature.
- A post may have a written explanation and it may include a photo or a video.
- Your child may not appear in all photos or videos, but if they are tagged, they have taken part in the learning.
- You will be able to comment on your child's posts. Teachers will be notified of your comments and they will read these. Please do not expect a reply from staff.
- **Tapestry is not a communication tool.** Any important communication must be face-to-face, via a call to the office or via an email to the office.
- Please do not allow children to comment on Tapestry and please do not share passwords with your children.
- Please remember that you have all agreed not to share any photos or videos from Tapestry on social media.


