Huckleberry Orchard Visit

Dear Parent/Carer,

In Early Years, our Topic in Term 5 is all about animals and habitats. To further enhance the children's understanding of animal habitats, identifying, naming and sorting animals by their homes and describing animal features, we would like to take Year R on a trip to **Huckleberry Orchard** on **Thursday 20th April 2023 for Miss Iles' Class** and **Friday 21st April for Miss Boatfield's Class**. These are **morning** visits only. The children will be able to encounter miniature farm animals; stroke, groom, walk and feed them.

The total price of the trip is £19 per child. This includes the cost of the coach journey and the centre entry fee. If we do not receive enough funds, we will have to regrettably cancel the event.

On the day of the trip, your child will need to wear school uniform and arrive to school as normal at 8:50am. We will be leaving school after registration and returning by 1.00pm to allow for the usual collection procedure. The children will need to wear school uniform, but they can wear any suitable and comfortable shoes e.g. wellington boots or trainers. They will NOT need any spending money for the trip. The children will need to bring a drink bottle, sun hat if warm and a light weight waterproof coat.

Every child will have a free packed lunch provided by the school kitchen this day as we will arrive back at school after our usual lunch sitting. Alternatively, they can bring their own packed lunch. (Please tick your preferred option on the attachment below).
