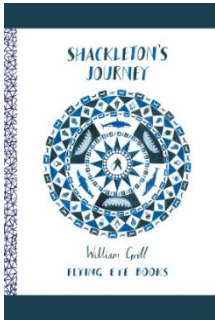


Year 3 Class Newsletter

We are beginning our topic of Poles Apart. Here are some of the exciting things we will be learning this term...

Topic

Our topic for Term 6 is Poles Apart where we will be having a Science and Geography focus! For the Science aspect, the children will be learning about forces and magnets. For the geographical side of it, the children will be learning about the position and significance of the Equator, Northern Hemisphere, Southern Hemisphere, Arctic and the Antarctic Circle.

Maths

In Maths this term we will be focusing on time, properties of shape and statistics. The children will be applying their knowledge of addition and subtraction to these and will be using problem solving skills. We will also continue to work on times tables.

English

In Reading, we will begin a new class reader, text Shackleton's Journey. In writing, the children will be developing their writing skills through writing biographies and narrative poems. We will also be working on skills such as speech marks and fronted adverbials.
