PE Kit:

- House PE t-shirt (colour of house)
- Shorts black/navy
- Track Suit for winter outdoor lessons black/navy
- Plimsolls for indoor PE
- Trainers for outdoor PE

We must insist parents name all items individually by using iron on labels or permanent marker. It is inevitable that children will misplace items of clothing accidentally and finding the owner is impossible without items named clearly.

Jewellery:

Children should not wear jewellery in school with the exception of watches or stud earrings.
