Please ensure that your child has wellington boots and a waterproof jacket in school everyday, so that they can access all areas at playtime.



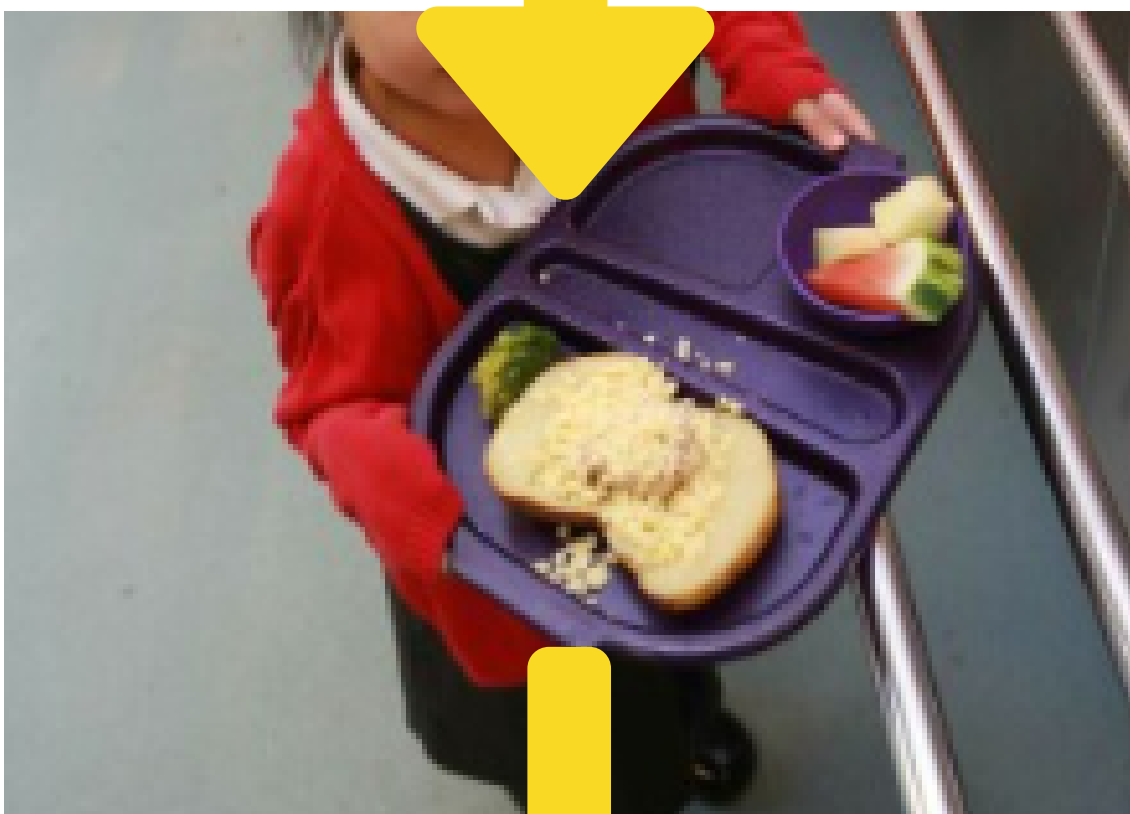
EATING A HOT DINNER AT LUNCHTIME

draw a face

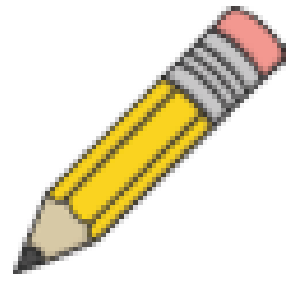


put on my socks

write the first letter

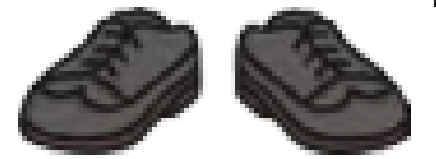
name the colours I use

clear away things I've used

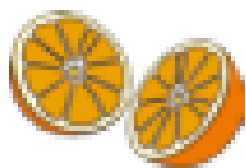
